Big Idea: God has great things for Exodus Church...and that should create trust, courage and mission.

Remember

Review the Big Idea. Ask how God spoke to the group through the sermon.

Are there questions you may have that to be answered?

Deepen

Read through vv. 5-6. Describe what has happened to Paul on the mission. How would this affect you?

In vv. 9-11, Paul receives God's Word at a time of struggle.
How do we know he was struggling?
How does God's Word give courage to Paul?

How has God's Word given you courage in your life? Can you give recent examples?

The Big Idea is that "God has great things for Exodus Church." What are some things God has done to this point on this journey?

What are some things we can pray for as we begin the next chapter of this journey together?

Transform

What are some areas in which you need courage from God to pursue what He has for you?

What are some ways in which you need to apply God's Word on the mission of Jesus in your life?

Talk as a group about v. 11. Imagine what that would have looked like for Paul.

Talk as a group about the next 18 months for Exodus.

What are some dreams you have for Exodus?

Can you point to specific Scriptures that reflect these dreams?

What are some dreams that can only happen by God's power and promise?

Close your time praying specifically for some of the things you mentioned.
