	<b>OLD COVENANT</b>	<b>NEW COVENANT</b>
<b>SACRIFICES</b>	Continually year after year—Day of Atonement (Hebrews 10:1)	Once at the consummation of the ages (Hebrews 9:26)
<b>BLOOD</b>	Blood of Bulls and goats (Hebrews 10:4)	Precious Blood of Jesus (Hebrews 10:19)
<b>ATONEMENT</b>	Covering—Sins were covered until a time of reformation. (Hebrews 9:8-10)	Removal—Sins were taken away by the Reformer—Jesus. (Hebrews 10:11-14)
<b>FORGIVENESS</b>	Yearly covering/ incomplete (Hebrews 10:1-4)	Once for all/complete (Hebrews 10:11-14)
<b>ACCESS TO GOD</b>	Only the high priest and then only once a year (Hebrews 9:7)	Anyone who will trust in Jesus/Any time (Hebrews 10:19-22)
