Big Idea: Sorrow and repentance are not the same thing – only one leads to life.

Remember

Think through the narrative of Exodus 7-11 highlighting Pharaoh's heart.

Think through the sermon and big idea from Sunday. What were some things that stood out to you?

Deepen

What was Pharaoh's response in Chapter 8 to the plague of Frogs?

Look at Psalm 51 and compare Pharaoh and David's response to God.

What is the difference in responding to God and responding to circumstances?

How do people in our culture generally interact with God when everything is going ok vs. during crisis?

Transform

What are some ways that you have personally responded to circumstances that you do not like or want to go away?

Pharaoh still found it hard to acknowledge his own sin or his identity in light of Who God is. How do you personally struggle to see yourself rightly in light of who God is?

How does Your view of God effect the ways you respond to Him? What do you believe wrongly about God or about yourself that causes you to respond similarly to Pharaoh?

What are some specific ways that you try to manipulate God?

What are some ways that you personally need to repent?

What keeps you from completely giving your life to Him?

Looking over the list of things in Psalm 51 with David's repentance, What are some areas that you need to acknowledge who you are and your sinfulness?
