Transform:

James 1:2-4

How Does our idea of God as a deliverer need to change?

In Exodus 6:6 God confronts Moses of his doubt and reminds him of the truth. Where do you need to repent of not believing who God is and what He has promised?

How can we help one another remember who God is and what he has promised?

How does "who God is" and "what He has promised" push us forward in the mission?
