Deepen

The primary point of the sermon is our tendency to trust in false gods when things aren't working out according to our timetable. How do you see this tendency in your own life?

What principles from the sermon do we see in the following passages?

- Isaiah 45:9-20
- Jeremiah 2:9-13

Looking at Exodus 32, they were literally saying that this calf they created would deliver them. Sounds crazy to think about, but how do we do that regularly? How do we set up false gods in our lives in which we are trusting for deliverance?

Brian talked about Moses as the Advocate for the people. In doing this, he points toward Jesus who stands as our advocate before the Father. Moses was an advocate who...

- Pleads for God's mercy.
- Confronts the sin in the people.
- Offered to stand in the place of the people taking their punishment and paying their debt.

Read 1 John 2:1-3. How does Jesus as our advocate fulfill what Moses pointed toward?

Transform

The idolatry in Exodus 32 can be traced to the people not waiting on the Lord. How do you need to wait on the Lord in your life this week?

How do you need to trust Him for deliverance rather than creating a false thing in which to hope?
