What are some training steps that Christians are called to in this passage?

Why are the gospel promises important?

Godliness has Value in Every way

Paul tells Timothy that godliness is of value in every way – in this life and in the one to come. Why is the value of godliness important to our pursuit of it?

Read Hebrews 11:23-26

How does Moses make a decision based on something’s value?

What can we learn from him in our pursuit of being “God-struck doers of the Word”?

Close your time talking about how your group can encourage one another toward godliness. What would that look like?
