- What are some steps you need to take to be a better steward of the resource of your time?

Treasure

- Why is money so close to our hearts that it would reflect what we love and worship?
- What are some steps you need to take to be a better steward of your money?
- What are some ways money has caused conflict in your life? family? relationships?
- Why is having a lot of money never the answer to money problems?

Talents/Gifts

- How has God uniquely gifted you?
- How can you serve him with that gift in your family? with your friends? at Exodus?
- What are some challenges to determining how to best utilize your gifts for God's Mission?

Transform

Read and discuss 1 Corinthians 6:19-20.

- Why is the truth that we are not our own good news?
- How does that need to seep into your life?
- Though the context is sexual sin in the church, how might the truth that we belong to God shape our understanding of our time, talent and treasure?
- What are some specific ways in which you need to repent in the way you handle God's Resources?
