Read 2 Timothy 2:1-13

What stands out to you about the passage?

What are some things that stood out to you from the sermon or our time together on Sunday?

Deepen

When you think about the relationship of Paul to Timothy in this passage - who are some people who have spoken truth into your life personally? Give everyone a moment to share.

How can we invest in replicating our understanding of truth and skills with which we serve within the local church? (Example - training others, doing our work unto the Lord, investing with humility)

Take a look at Paul's encouragement to Timothy again in vs 1-2. What happens if our kingdom efforts are done in our own strength rather than the Grace that is in Christ Jesus?

Read Philippians 2:12-13

We work hard and God's grace works in us. How should this inform the way that we labor for the gospel?

Think of the examples of the soldier, athlete, and farmer. What do you most relate to? How does that metaphor challenge you personally? (devotion of a soldier, discipline of an athlete, diligence of the farmer)

Transform

Read Ephesians 4:11-16

What is the purpose here in this passage for our gifts?

Would some of you be willing to share about your experience serving in the local Church? What have been some of your best experiences?

How can we encourage one another to labor together for the Kingdom of God?
