When you think about the truth of the story (rooted in the Resurrection of Jesus), how does that give you greater confidence in the Bible?

#### Transform

How have you experienced your own heart reflecting the men in the passage?

- Slow to believe - v. 25.
- Blind - v. 31.

What changed your heart? Made you more open to the Lord?
