Key Details

We are pursuing the purchase of a 12.23 acre piece of land located on Kee Road between Wilkinson and McAdenville Road here in Belmont. It is our hope to then construct a facility for our gathered ministry activities.

Land Purchase Price: \$485,000.00

FAQ's

What will members be voting on? Exodus Belmont members will be voting to affirm the following statement: "I prayerfully approve the purchase of the Kee Road property as presented by the Elders. Yes or No."

When will the vote be? Only Exodus Belmont members who completed the membership process will vote. This vote will be conducted electronically between Sunday, January 29th, and Wednesday, February 1st.

Will we need to fundraise? We do anticipate the need to have fundraising that will bring in additional funding over and above our general giving for normal ministry activities.

How will the Stretch Campaign money be used? Exodus will use all "Building Fund" (funds raised from our prior Stretch Campaign) money to go toward purchasing land and any other construction related expenses.

How will the location change impact the proximity to our current church family? The Kee Road land is located near I 85 and Hwy 74 making it easy to get there. It is a 5-minute drive from our current location.

What will the new building cost? Our site plan has not yet been decided upon and therefore an estimate is not yet available. That said, we've "counted the cost" and done some general planning with professionals in the real estate and construction fields who have helped us feel confident in moving forward at this time.

When can we expect to be in the new building? It is our hope to be ready to move to into the new facility as soon as possible, which we expect will be approximately 2-3 years from the time of the land purchase.

Do we plan to borrow money for any part of this project? Exodus seeks to make wise decisions that allow us to care for our growing church family. We do not currently have enough money to construct a

facility without the use of borrowed funds. We would seek to borrow the needed amount with a plan to repay it.
