Jesus is the Bread of Life. How does this passage speak to his

- Uniqueness
- Sufficiency
- Power to Save

In John 6, Jesus is compared to manna. This first appears in Exodus 16. Talk through the passage.

- People are grumbling - v. 3.
- God provides - vv. 4-5.
- The people gather - vv. 13-26
- Some doubt - vv. 27-30

What are some similarities between the manna and Jesus? Differences?

Transform

How does Jesus use bread as a metaphor for following him?

- Eating as believing
- Feeding as abiding

Notice that the source of life to become a Christian is the same source of life to remain and endure as a Christian. Why is this important? Why do we run to other things so quickly?

What are places we run to find bread rather than the Bread of life? Is God convicting you personally of any areas?
