# SAFETY FOR KIDS

We are excited and grateful for all the families who serve Exodus Church together. We want to encourage everyone to participate, so we have set some guidelines to help ensure the safety of everyone on Demo Day.

Families are encouraged to attend the groundbreaking ceremony together. Parents are responsible for their own children and should keep the children close during this time as this is an active construction site near a busy main road with uneven ground. It will be very safe where we are for the groundbreaking ceremony, but parents need to actively keep children in this safe area.

Once the ceremony is finished, we will begin our Demo Day work and the following age restrictions will apply.

- Ages 4 and under will not be allowed on the construction site after the groundbreaking.
- Ages 5-11 will be allowed to work in specific non-demolition areas alongside a parent.
- Ages 12-17 will be allowed to work on teams throughout the building.

Parents are required to sign a waiver for themselves and their children.

Children ages 5-11 will be working in safer areas and are required to be accompanied by a parent at all times. They are not allowed to go anywhere outside these safe zones.
